The simple natural stones

bordering the garden beds are engraved with the name, year of birth and year of death. When desired, the Garden may be used as the repository for the cremated remains of present or former members and attenders of Adelphi Friends Meeting as well as their family members.

Information about the engraving of a stone or the placement of ashes can be obtained from the clerk of the Memorial Garden Committee. The fee for the use of the memorial Garden and the engraving of the stone is determined annually.

An album of photos and written remembrances of the deceased is also maintained by the Memorial Garden Committee. More information can be obtained from the clerk of that committee.



Memorial services are

arranged through the Ministry and Worship Committee. Each family may decide whether to have a private or more inclusive ceremony at the time of the internment of ashes and the placement of the stone.
